**REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF SPECIAL DISCOVERY MAGISTRATE RE:  
PLAINTIFF TERRY BOLLEA'S MOTION TO COMPEL DEPOSITION OF  
DEFENDANT GAWKER MEDIA, LLC (JOHN COOK)**

This cause came before Special Discovery Magistrate James Case on March 17, 2015, on Plaintiff Terry Bollea's Motion to Compel Deposition of Defendant Gawker Media, LLC (John Cook) (the "Motion"). The Special Discovery Magistrate, having reviewed the moving and opposition papers, and having heard oral argument thereon, now recommends that:

(1) Plaintiff's Motion be **granted**;


