BY ORDER OF THE COURT:

The emergency motion for provisional stay filed by the appellants, Nicholas Guido Denton and Albert J. Daulerio (hereafter "Denton and Daulerio"), is granted to the extent that the enforcement of the judgment on appeal is stayed as to Denton and Daulerio for thirty (30) days from the date of this order or until the trial court enters a written order denying a stay or granting a stay on conditions, whichever comes first, after which the provisional stay granted in this order shall expire. During the period that the provisional stay is in effect, the parties may re-address in the trial court all issues regarding a stay of the judgment. The trial court may re-address the original motion to stay, the result of the prior hearing on that motion, the appellee's motion to vacate or modify stay, any response to that motion, and the result of any additional hearing or hearings. Upon the completion of the trial court's re-examination of this matter, the trial court shall enter a written order either denying a stay or granting a stay upon appropriate conditions with regard to Denton and Daulerio. The emergency motion for stay filed by Denton and Daulerio is denied without prejudice to the parties to file a motion for the review of any written order regarding a stay entered by the trial court either during or after the period of the provisional stay granted in this order.

This court acknowledges that the automatic stay imposed by section 362 of the Bankruptcy Code remains in effect as to the appellant, Gawker Media, LLC.
