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When we take them, we will then go around, because GMGI is in bankruptcy and Gawker Media is in bankruptcy, well, we'll file proof of claims against them to assert those rights, those indemnity rights that Mr. Daulerio has, against those companies. We think at this point it is against both companies.

There were some arguments raised about positions that we took in the bankruptcy case. We were very careful on our filings in the bankruptcy case to only attack the indemnity rights of Gawker Media. We didn't attack the indemnity rights of GMGI. GMGI is a Cayman Islands company. Their laws are different. You can indemnify people for intentional torts in the Cayman Islands.

And the indemnity rights we're talking about are a pattern and a practice, which we learned through depositions in that case, after our response was actually filed, that Mr. Denton was assured that his indemnity rights for both companies would be honored.

We assumed that Mr. Daulerio got the same assurance because they've stated publicly that they're not going to cut their riders loose and
