**ORDER RE: PLAINTIFF TERRY BOLLEA'S MOTION FOR  
CLARIFICATION OF THE COURT'S DECEMBER 17, 2014 DISCOVERY ORDER**

This cause came before the Court on March 19, 2015, on Plaintiff Terry Bollea's Motion for Clarification of the Court's December 17, 2014 Discovery Order. The Court has reviewed the Court file, reviewed and considered the Motion and response papers, heard argument of counsel, and is otherwise fully advised. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, as follows:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED in part**, and **DENIED in part**.
2. Plaintiff shall serve a revised subpoena to YAC (the "Revised Subpoena"), which does not call for a deposition and includes only the following document requests:
  - a) All tax returns (including federal, state and foreign country tax returns), and portions thereof, filed by Gawker Media, LLC and its affiliated companies covering any income during the period of January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2013.
  - b) All financial statements (including but not limited to balance sheets, income statements, statements of changes to financial position, statements

of profits and/or losses, and statements of assets and liabilities) of Gawker Media, LLC and its affiliated companies covering financial information relating to the period of January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2013.

- c) All bank statements of Gawker Media, LLC and its affiliated companies relating to funds held during the period between January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2013.

3. Because counsel for YAC has agreed to accept service of the Revised Subpoena and YAC shall serve all responsive documents no later than 20 days from its counsel's receipt of service, the fact discovery cutoff in this action will be extended, only in connection with the Revised Subpoena and only to the extent necessary to allow the third party discovery to YAC to be completed.

4. This Order is made without prejudice to Plaintiff revisiting with the Court any and all issues raised in Plaintiff's Motion and/or the hearing, following YAC's production of documents in response to the Revised Subpoena and/or Plaintiff's filing of a Motion for Leave to Add Claim for Punitive Damages.
