COUNT I

The amount in controversy exceeds, exclusive of interest and costs, the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000). This Court has jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1332.

2. Defendants Johnson & Wood, P.A. and Johnson were at all relevant times engaged in the practice of law in Hennepin County, Minnesota and maintained an office in

the meaning of Minn. Stat. Section 8.31, Subd. 1, giving rise to a private cause of action in Plaintiff pursuant to Minn. Stat. Section 8.31, subd. 3a.

13. Plaintiff has suffered damages in an amount in excess of \$50,000 and incurred costs and disbursements, including costs of investigation and reasonable attorney's fees, in a yet unknown amount, caused by Defendants' said unfair and unlawful actions.

WHEREFORE Plaintiff prays judgment against the Defendants, and each of them:

A. awarding Plaintiff damages in a sum in excess of \$50,000.00;

B. awarding Plaintiff his attorney's fees and other costs and disbursements; and

C. awarding Plaintiff such other relief as the Court deems just and equitable.

JURY DEMAND

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 38(b) and Local Rule LR 38.1, Plaintiff demands a trial by jury on all issues so triable.
