SWAY CALLOWAY: Yes! Yeah! "Sway In The Morning," Shade 45, he is here. Twelve-time world champion, my buddy, citizen of "Sway In The Morning," Hulk Hogan is here.

TERRY BOLLEA: Sway Mania in the house, my brother. I am in the safe zone. Thank God.

CALLOWAY: What are you going to do when Sway Mania comes for – can you say that? Turn the music down.

BOLLEA: Three, two, one – what are you going to do, brother, when Sway Mania runs wild on you, dude?

CALLOWAY: Did we get that?

MR. : Yes.

CALLOWAY: All right, Hulk Hogan, ladies and gentlemen.

BOLLEA: Cool, man. Cool.

CALLOWAY: Hulk Hogan, man, the last time you were here, man, we had such a great conversation, an in-depth conversation about your new life's philosophy.

BOLLEA: Yeah, man.

CALLOWAY: And you've been going through so much, stuff, man, Hulk, and –

BOLLEA: Yo, yo.

CALLOWAY: - you know, I'm just going to keep 100 with you, man.

BOLLEA: I'm good with it.

CALLOWAY: I see – you know, we all grew up watching Hulk Hogan and – you know, and you're still a hero to everybody, even though you've gone through so much controversy –

BOLLEA: Yeah.

CALLOWAY: – in your life, you know, for all these years, and you know – and still, you know, I've been watching the news and seeing you all over the –

BOLLEA: Yeah.

CALLOWAY: – news. And we talked about this actually, the last time you were here, about this infamous sex tape –

BOLLEA: Right.

CALLOWAY: – that was done, like, six years ago. And it's leaked now, and then you've been having to explain yourself, explain what it is, your position on it.

BOLLEA: Yeah.

CALLOWAY: And I've watched you on TMZ. I've seen you everywhere, man. And you

know, what can you tell our citizens?

They haven't had a chance to talk to you. You know, how do you feel about this? You had a rough week.

BOLLEA: Well, let me – do we have time for me to lay out, straight-up??

CALLOWAY: This is your show. Hey, this is –

BOLLEA: OK, good. Well, let me explain to you – even though I have this new life – why all this crazy, negative stuff or what people think might be bad stuff is happening. And it's really not bad stuff.

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: It's really actually bad stuff in disguise that is good stuff, like a dark cloud, so that some day when it goes away it will make me a better person. And it's kind of, like, called a gestation period, you know, because if you get your chick pregnant –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: – you know, you don't ask her a month later, where's the baby at. You know what I'm saying?

CALLOWAY: Mmm hmm. Mmm hmm.

BOLLEA: It takes – there's a natural time it takes for things to happen in the world.

So what is happening here is, even though the pendulum has swung back the other way, and all the crazy, wild stuff I did has stopped, and you know, I went through – I bottomed out, you know, I – and I realized that all that stuff about – you know, it's tough to make money, and rednecks are bad people, and you know, Japanese or Chinese people are smart, all that stuff that you hear that your parents fight so you got to fight or, you know, you get divorced, so maybe you should get divorced, all that stuff that you hear, bro, all that stuff that's going on, none of that stuff is true.

That's all inherited stuff that you inherit –

CALLOWAY: Yeah, yeah. Uh-huh.

BOLLEA: – from this world. What's true is the inherent; the peace, love, joy, the happiness that's in you.

So I dug that. I realized that's what's real, and that's what I want to be.

CALLOWAY: (Inaudible.)

BOLLEA: So what happened was, is I was in this crazy world of craziness, and I didn't realize what was real, I was running trying to keep up with everybody, right? So a bunch of stuff happened – made some bad choices, totally accountable. It's all me.

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: But what's happened now is, like, the pendulum is swinging back the other way, you know –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: – from all this craziness? It's swinging back the good way to where I was meant to be and the better person I'm supposed to be. But it's kind of like, when a spinning wheel stops –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: – stuff keeps flying off for a while. You got to pay for everything you do in this life –

CALLOWAY: Damn, yeah.

BOLLEA: – you know? It's that energy, bro. For that energy that you put out, your life is a mirror of what kind of energy you put out.

So if you're all beat up and woe-is-me and this and that and the other, if you want a better life, put out a better vibe –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: – and you'll attract better stuff.

So what's happening is I ran so hard, and I made some bad choices. And I'm not blaming anybody – totally accountable. I'm the king of stepping up and saying, I did it, you know?

CALLOWAY: Yeah, you are. That's what I know. That's what I like about you.

BOLLEA: And I won't lie to you, you know? And I got this new life, and if I had been in this situation with my buddy's girl, and I was married to my new wife, Jennifer, I'd tell her –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: — because I don't want to hurt or lie to anybody because I have to look at myself in the mirror. When everybody's gone — and for a while everybody was gone; it was just me — I had to be able to look at myself in the mirror. So at the end of the day, you know, all this negative stuff and all this wrap, and I don't want to put a woe-is-me story out there because everybody's got one.

CALLOWAY: (Inaudible.)

BOLLEA: She's got one. I've got one. You got one.

CALLOWAY: Yeah, Heather B. definitely got one.

BOLLEA: (Inaudible) – that's, so what?

BOLLEA: Nobody cares about woe-is-me because everybody's got one.

HEATHER GARDNER: Yeah, who cares?

BOLLEA: They care about: What now?

CALLOWAY: You know, yeah.

CALLOWAY: Well, you know what I want to do? I want to come back.

BOLLEA: No, I got to tell you right now. You said this is my show. You said this was my show. Did you say that?

CALLOWAY: Oh, no, right. But forgive me. You know what? Yeah, you're right. We're not going to play any songs.

BOLLEA: Did you say that?

CALLOWAY: This is your show – Hulk Hogan.

BOLLEA: Thank you. Well, let me at least finish this thought, bro.

CALLOWAY: No, man, because I'm going to give you – (inaudible) – go ahead.

BOLLEA: Thank you. And so – anyway, so where we're at now is, you know, at the end of the day, I did this. I wasn't on drugs. I made a choice, but the woe-is-me story is, on a personal level, dude, my life was already screwed –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: — with my situation. I was at an all-time low. These two people — that I pray to God are friends of mine, you know — for two years they were going, hey, you know, I want to get with you. I want to do this.

And then my boy is going, yeah, it's cool. It's cool.

I was, like – (inaudible) –

CALLOWAY: Are you talking about the threesome or, I mean – (inaudible) –

BOLLEA: No, no, no. No, him offering his wife to me, yeah.

CALLOWAY: His wife – OK.

You didn't think that was weird the first time he offered you his wife?

BOLLEA: Well, I knew they partied, you know?

CALLOWAY: Oh, OK. OK.

BOLLEA: And I'd heard stories, and his wife was gorgeous. And she kept saying, I want to get with you.

I want to do this and that and the other stuff and I want to have sex with you.

And I said, no, no, no, no, no.

So at the end of the day I kind of bottomed out, you know?

CALLOWAY: Mmm hmm.

CALLOWAY: And you did it?

BOLLEA: Let's do this thing.

And now I've defended him. I've fought for him. You know, even with his old boss Howard Stern, I fought for him yesterday going, I don't believe you'd do this.

Howard said he don't believe it.

Last night I didn't sleep a bit, bro, because –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: – I got some information last night that said that he was the one that set the camera up, and he did this to me.

And I – even the person that said to me, Harvey at TMZ –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: – (inaudible) – I don't believe it. I've got to see the film to believe it.

And you know, because if he did that to me, we were never friends, you know –

CALLOWAY: Yeah, mmm hmm, mmm hmm.

BOLLEA: – and everything was a lie and even to the point where, even last week, you know, when I said the criminal thing is going down, bro, I got to know. I said, I got to know.

And I don't want to insult you, but even your son, Tyler, who I love to death, he's like the sacrificial lamb.

He's on the altar. I said, if something happens to you, you go to jail or you get sued or you get caught up in this mess, it's going to affect him. I said, I got to do what I got to do but I got to know the truth, bro. Did you have anything to do with this? Because you know, if you didn't, God bless you. I love you.

CALLOWAY: Yeah, yeah.

BOLLEA: But if you did, we were never friends, but it will change my attitude about what I got to do.

But now, I mean, I just got to, you know, release the Kraken because there's – it's criminal.

CALLOWAY: Yeah, yeah.

BOLLEA: It's civil. And to this point right now, I want to believe in my heart, you know, that he's my friend. I just – but I got some information that rattled me so I couldn't sleep.

CALLOWAY: Well, what's the – Bubba – we're talking about Bubba –

BOLLEA: The Love Sponge.

CALLOWAY: – the Love Sponge. And his wife Heather is a person that you slept with. What is the information you received?

BOLLEA: The information was Harvey at TMZ, and Mike Walters called me and said they – when you write something down from a tape, what do you call that? Transcribed?

CALLOWAY: Transcribed, yeah, yeah.

BOLLEA: They said they transcribed the words to me. They read it to me over the phone that after they left the room, they said that Bubba went in, and as he's walking towards the camera, he said, this is our retirement if we ever need it, Heather.

I said: Harvey, did you see the tape?

And he said, no, I didn't.

I said, well, then I don't believe you.

And then Mike Walter – someone else came on the line, on a conference call. He said, Hulk, this is executive producer of the show. And I saw the tape with Mike, and we wouldn't lie about something like this. It would be hundreds of millions of dollars, and Bubba –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: I said, brother, I have to see the tape and I couldn't hang the phone up fast enough. I started shaking violently.

CALLOWAY: Yeah, yeah, yeah.

BOLLEA: Dude, I couldn't stop. You know, I thought I was going to have a heart attack, couldn't even push the button to call for help. So I see my attorney calling me, David Houston, like, for 10 minutes. My arms were going like this, man. I'd never had my body out of control.

Finally, I hit the button and I don't know if I was crying. I was going – I couldn't get through it. And finally he talked me down, but that's why I haven't slept. That's why – because you know, that's a tough one for me. And I've been through some shit, bro, and this is a tough one.

CALLOWAY: (Inaudible.) Well, because you realize now that, if this is true, that the entire time that friendship with Bubba was a farce, you were set up.

Now this is like defamation. It's degrading. DJ Wonder's a good friend of mine. If we had that experience, and I found out that he set me up like that, the first thing I would want to do is beat his ass.

BOLLEA: Do you understand why I don't believe it? Because you know, if someone's your friend, they wouldn't take you when you're at an all-time low –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

GARDNER: Right.

BOLLEA: – and do this to you, if they know you were that low –

CALLOWAY: Mmm hmm.

BOLLEA: – and they wouldn't go to a camera and go, hey, you know, this is my retirement.

I mean, that means – that means – if he did this, that means that he not only set me up but he did it for money.

CALLOWAY: And he didn't give a shit about you. What did you – what was your – what did you want to do to him? Did you want to reach out to him? Or did you – (inaudible) –

BOLLEA: Dude, I've called him. I've called him, and there was response. And you know, now his attorney called me.

And Bubba told my attorney, like, three or four days ago, I'm not lawyering up. Before we heard this information, Bubba goes, I'm not lawyering up. I'm on your team. You know, screw the bitch – this and that and the other. He just was, like, you know, hey, I'm on your team. I'm not lawyering up.

And so I called him, you know, to try to see what was up. And the next thing I know, I got a call back from his lawyer.

CALLOWAY: Yeah, yeah. He's a – hey, man, he's a snake.

BOLLEA: And so I just sent – and I just sent my lawyer's – his lawyer's number to my lawyer, and I just – and I just haven't slept, man. So I'm praying –

CALLOWAY: That sounds real snake-ish, man.

BOLLEA: No, that's the truth.

CALLOWAY: (Inaudible.)

BOLLEA: And I'm not lying here. I'm just trying to -

CALLOWAY: Well, he sounds snake-ish.

BOLLEA: – I'm trying to keep the faith because I've got very few friends in my life, you know?

GARDNER: Right.

CALLOWAY: Yeah. All right, you know, in the tape you mention Nick a lot. And so your phone rang in this tape. You've seen the tape, right?

BOLLEA: I saw the front of it, bro.

CALLOWAY: Yeah, the front of it?

BOLLEA: And it made me so sick. You know, I think there's, like, a minute, 40 of it. I probably watched a minute of it.

CALLOWAY: Yeah, and it made you sick? Have you had to talk to your kids (about this ?)?

BOLLEA: Yeah, bro, yeah.

Well, here's – the deal is, at the time I was living at my big house we film "Hogan Knows Best" in with like, Nick's precision driving team.

GARDNER: Right.

BOLLEA: You know, my wife had split and she was in LA and she was very unhappy with the marriage.

And it just – it was what it was, you know? And I kept out holding out hope, but you know, she pretty much told me that, you know, things weren't happening anymore.

So you know, I shouldn't have been over at that house. And when - I was supposed to be home by midnight because -

BOLLEA: – I think Nick and the boys were coming. I was supposed to meet them. So when the phone rang, I went, oh, my gosh. It's probably Nick.

And when I went to the phone, it wasn't him, you know?

CALLOWAY: Was that – was that a Brooke song? (Inaudible) – Brooke song? I heard – (inaudible) – song.

BOLLEA: Yeah. Oh, dude. Oh, dude. Oh, God, it killed me. Oh, God, it killed me.

CALLOWAY: Yeah, yeah, yeah, yeah.

BOLLEA: But-

CALLOWAY: His ringer was his daughter's song.

BOLLEA: Yeah, yeah. Oh, wow. That's brutal.

CALLOWAY: Yeah.. You know what, Hulk? Let's talk because you're not here just for that. And – but –

BOLLEA: No, no, no, no, but – no, but at the end of the day –

CALLOWAY: Yeah?

BOLLEA: – I forgot the question that you asked me.

CALLOWAY: Did you – how did you talk to – (inaudible) –

BOLLEA: Oh, no, no, no. At the end of the day, that's what I'm saying.

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: This guy, if he was my friend, if my - and I still pray to God he is - if my kids were younger, I could have lost my kids, man.

CALLOWAY: Yeah, yeah.

BOLLEA: You know, but now they're older. They understand all the drama and all the craziness I went through because they still have to deal with it.

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: But I'm just saying, you know, that's something that's calculated. It's something that – I said something on Twitter. I said, it feels like a dream. I can't – why would someone do that to another human being?

CALLOWAY: But can I ask you a question, though? Why did you – I mean, she had to – I saw – Heather is – at that time had a banging body – sexy girl. But why – did you want to bang her out? I mean, did you want to do that? I mean, what made you say –

BOLLEA: Well, no. No, here's the deal. Heather has always been totally nice to me –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: – great mother. I mean, you know, and I'd heard that her and Bubba partied, but it never had nothing to do with me.

When I bottomed out, for somebody to take me to the house and offer this – and me just go, the hell with it; I don't even care about even living anymore – I mean, and then if someone set a camera up and said it was for money, I mean, who does that to somebody?

CALLOWAY: A very diabolical individual –

BOLLEA: So I'm saying, that's why I'm praying to God he's still my friend, bro –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: – because if not, I mean –

CALLOWAY: I mean, I hope he is, but it sounds as if - I mean, TMZ's executive producer - legally they wouldn't even have told you that because that makes the two of them liable.

BOLLEA: Do you understand – do you understand why I have to see that tape? Do you understand why I got to see that?

CALLOWAY: You need to see the tape. Man, I do understand. There was – did you have any – at least any enjoyment in that moment, do you recall, or – that made it – I know it wasn't worth it, but from what I saw, it looked like you all had fun.

BOLLEA: Dude, I knew – I knew the whole time I was there –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: – it was wrong. It was – it made me – you know, for whatever physical release there was, whatever it was, there was. But it was – I was sick. I knew I was – you know what's good and what's bad.

GARDNER: Right.

CALLOWAY: (Inaudible) – yeah.

BOLLEA: You know when you're happy or sad. I knew I was wrong. I knew I was doing wrong. I knew it was – I knew all along, you know, but –

CALLOWAY: Mmm hmm.

GARDNER: Right.

BOLLEA: And I don't want to say the woe-is-me thing, bro, and I don't want to blame anybody.

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: I don't blame my ex-wife. I don't blame anybody for where my head was at. But I was at – if you can understand that –

CALLOWAY: (Inaudible.)

BOLLEA: – that I was at an all-time low, when I said, OK, to hell with it. (Inaudible.)

CALLOWAY: You know, I appreciate – Hulk Hogan is here, first of all. And I don't know if I ever interviewed anyone who's been more honest than you have every time you come up here.

And I really appreciate that. I don't want to harbor on it because I wish you well. I hope at the end of the day, whatever comes out of this, it seems like you've already started to – you know, you accept your responsibility, and you're being accountable for your actions in this.

GARDNER: Yes, he did.

CALLOWAY: After the show, we sat and talked about how good we all felt –

GARDNER: Felt -

CALLOWAY: – about where you are in your life right now.

BOLLEA: Nothing's changed, man.

CALLOWAY: Yeah, so – and it's just like you said. It's one more hurdle. Life is a reflection of yourself. What you put in the universe, you get back. Still paying dues – you still got a lot of karma obviously out there that's floating around.

I want to open up the phone lines for our listeners because people love you.

BOLLEA: No, but I got to explain one thing to you. You know, and I don't know if I said it correctly. But when I talk about someone's life being flipped upside-down, I mean, I've been through a lot, bro.

BOLLEA: But I've never had anything flip on me like this. I've never had – and this was yesterday. I've never had a day in my life like yesterday. I've been in front of the feds. I've been under the hot light. My marriage, lawsuits – you know, I've had people tell me I was never going to walk again after back surgeries. I've had a lot of stuff laid on me. And this – that yesterday, in finding that out was probably the toughest and the most traumatic and just flipped my world upside-down more than anything ever has.

CALLOWAY: Dude, let me ask you - a lot of people say, well, you know, Hulk Hogan, you know, is a - you know, is a wrestler. There's a lot of acting in wrestling. These guys are entertainers. How much of this is true? Did they set this up? Is he in on it?

A lot of people have questioned if this is just a ploy perhaps. Or is it – is this – you know, is this some type of act that's happening? What do you say to people who question – who question whether or not this is valid, that this is not just you and Bubba putting together some script that you already pre-planned, and now it's playing itself out?

BOLLEA: That would be a hard one to answer, you know? I don't know who would do this to their children, you know?

CALLOWAY: Yeah, mmm hmm.

BOLLEA: I don't know who would do this to their new wife because I've already lost everything once.

BOLLEA: I've never had anybody that really has been – loves me and in love with me. I don't know why you'd throw that away. And at the end of the day, when people like Vivid and

different companies are offering you an open checkbook for any amount of money you want to write, why – if this was a plan, why wouldn't we cash in, or why wouldn't – (inaudible) – so I don't really know how to answer that question –

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: – you know, other than just watch what happens. And I mean, I don't know what else to say. I wouldn't know how to answer that because I wouldn't want to do that to myself or anybody else or my kids.

CALLOWAY: Yeah – (inaudible) – yeah, mmm hmm.

BOLLEA: Or I mean, why would you do that –

CALLOWAY: How was Nick? What did Nick and Brooke say?

BOLLEA: They've been through so much, you know?

They've been through so much and they know who I am. And now that they've grown up, they see the person I am, and they pretty much, you know, know the other side of the coin, you know?

CALLOWAY: Are they mad that this is happening because it's put them back in the spotlight in a controversial way?

BOLLEA: Brooke has never done a thing wrong and she's been drug through the mud by me, the divorce, my ex-wife, all the drama. So the kids have been through a lot and they know what time it is.

CALLOWAY: Yeah.

BOLLEA: You know, and they really have matured a lot. And I'm just, thank God that they're straight-up as they are because I could have lost them, too, through all of this.

CALLOWAY: Yeah, yeah.

Hulk Hogan is hanging out with us.

Man, I really appreciate you, man, because this honest about this. And there's a big event. I don't want to change subjects but I want to make sure before the show ends we talk about the TNA pay-per-view event.

So I want to come back and talk about that.

A lot of controversial video footage came out recently, an incident that took place years ago with Hulk Hogan and what seemed to be a friend – hopefully is – Bubba Love Sponge and his wife at the time, Heather. And they had a sexual encounter that was filmed, against your knowledge, that has recently leaked. And you've been talking to us about – you know, how upsetting it's been and how it's impacted your family.

Does it make you want to punch him, that this is happening?

BOLLEA: It's just – no, it's just so unbelievable. It's just – seems – it just doesn't seem real, you know, because it's not like – what would violence do at this point? CALLOWAY: Mmm hmm. Deception?

Putting you in this –

BOLLEA: It's just – you know, so that's why I'm holding out, man. I'm holding out.
