## ORDER DIRECTING CLERK TO UNSEAL RECORDS

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on April 11, 2016, upon the Intervenors' Motion to Unseal all Judicial Records Currently Filed Under Seal, dated March 21, 2016. Appearing before the Court were Kenneth Turkel and Shane Vogt, attorneys for the Plaintiff; Rachel Fugate, attorney for the Defendant, Gawker; and Robert Rogers and Allison Steele, attorneys for the Intervenors. The Court has considered the Motion, argument of counsel and is otherwise duly advised in the premises and therefore it is hereby

**ORDERED** that the Clerk of Court is hereby **DIRECTED to UNSEAL** each of the records in the October 28, 2015 and November 18, 2015 Orders and to make them available in the case file for this action for inspection and/or copying by the press and public.

The records to be unsealed are:

- 1. Defendants' Motion to Dismiss on Grounds of Fraud on the Court and exhibits 1 through 16, and 18 through 63 thereto, e-filed December 22, 2015. (Specifically **NOT Exhibit 17** which is to remain SEALED.)
- 2. All exhibits to Defendants' Motion to Compel Improperly Withheld Documents, e-filed December 22, 2015 (the Motion was previously unsealed);
- 3. Defendants' Motion for Access to Corrected and Unredacted DVDs, including the full brief and all exhibits thereto, e-filed December 22, 2015;
- 4. Plaintiff's Omnibus Response in Opposition to Defendants' "Disguised Motion for Rehearing," including the full brief and all exhibits thereto, e-filed January 12, 2016;
- 5. Defendants' Motion in Limine No. 1: Evidence Concerning the FBI Investigation and exhibits 1 through 6 and 8 through 15 thereto, e-filed February 1, 2016. (Specifically **NOT Exhibit 7** which is to remain SEALED.)

- 6. Defendants' Motion In Limine No. 2: Evidence Concerning Plaintiff's Use of Racial Slurs On A Sex Tape and Exhibits 1 through 14 and 16 through 19 thereto, e-filed February 1, 2016. (Specifically **NOT Exhibit 15** which is to remain SEALED.)
- 7. "Appendix Containing A Timeline of Key Events, Evidence and Testimony in Support of Defendants' Motion in Limine No. 2: Evidence Concerning Plaintiff's Use of Racial Slurs On A Sex Tape", and exhibits thereto, #030712, #041912, #042612, #052112, #100412, #100512, #100812, #100912, #101012, #101112, #101212, #101312, #101412, #101512, #101612, #101712, #102512, #121412, e-filed February 1, 2016;
- 8. Defendants' Motion in Limine No. 3: Relevant Excerpts From DVDs Produced By The FBI and exhibits thereto, e-filed February 1, 2016;
- 9. Defendants' Supplemental Brief Re: Plaintiff's Motion in Limine No. 3 To Exclude Evidence Or Argument Related To Settlement, and exhibits thereto, e-filed February 1, 2016; and
- 10. Defendants' Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion in Limine No. 24: To Exclude Argument or Evidence of Illegally Recorded Audio of Terry Bollea and Any Evidence Derived Therefrom, and exhibits thereto, e-filed February 12, 2016.
- 11. The Court declines to grant any portion of Intervenors' Motion to unseal any additional pleadings or exhibits that have not been specifically designated in accordance with Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.240.

In closing, the Court would like to remind counsel of their ethical obligations under the Professionalism Expectations adopted by the Florida Bar Board of Governors on January 30, 2015, 5.10 A Lawyer should attempt to resolve disagreements before requesting a court hearing. Preparing for hearings in this case takes a tremendous amount of time, not only for the parties, but also for the Court. To prepare for this hearing the Court compared the requested items with the items that have already been published by the Second District Court of Appeals and with the items previously unsealed by this Court. If the parties and intervenors agree on various issues, there is no need to schedule hearing time, simply submit an order with a cover letter expressing the agreement.
