## 1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 Thereupon,

3 OFFICER MARIUSZ LINOWSKI

4 was called as a witness by the DEFENDANT and having first  
5 been duly sworn by the court reporter was examined and  
6 testified on his oath as follows:

## 7 DIRECT EXAMINATION

8 BY MS. MILLER:

9 Q. If you could tell us your first and last name and  
10 spell your last name, please.

11 A. Mariusz Linowski, L-I-N-O-W-S-K-I.

12 Q. Where are you employed, sir?

13 A. St. Petersburg Police Department.

14 Q. In what capacity?

15 A. Police officer.

16 Q. Patrol?

17 A. Yes.

18 Q. Where were you employed likewise in September  
19 of 2018?20 A. I was a detective with Special Victims Unit at  
21 the time.22 Q. It seems like everybody left SVU since then.  
23 Everybody we've deposed today --

24 A. Everybody transferred, yes.

25 Q. Any reason? Just didn't want to be in SVU anymore?

1 A. Career progression.

2 Q. Do you have to go back to Patrol?

3 A. It's whatever people choose to do.

4 Q. We're here today an State of Florida versus  
5 Charisse Stinson? Are you familiar with this case?

6 A. Yes, I am.

7 Q. Did you write your own supplemental police report  
8 reference your involvement?

9 A. No, I did not.

10 Q. You have reviewed Sergeant Nagle's?

11 A. Correct.

12 Q. Is it accurate, as far as you recall, for your  
13 involvement in the case?

14 A. Yes.

15 Q. Is there anything you would add to it?

16 A. No.

17 Q. Or change?

18 A. No.

19 Q. Tell me what you did.

20 A. So it was September 2nd, 2018 when we were  
21 activated as members of the CART team for the region  
22 by FDLE.

23 My involvement started upon my arrival at the  
24 Enclave apartments. I was advised that the entire team was  
25 already present in that complex. We were tasked with going

1 from door-to-door filling out CART forms in an attempt to  
2 identify any potential witnesses that might have any  
3 pertinent information reference the missing child.

4 Q. And you went straight from home --

5 A. Yes.

6 Q. -- to the Enclave?

7 A. Correct.

8 Q. I understand there was like a pre-briefing at  
9 Largo Police Department.

10 A. Yes, yes. The people who lived closer made it  
11 to that briefing but I live farther so it took me longer  
12 to get there.

13 Q. Okay.

14 Anybody at the Enclave tell you anything  
15 interesting?

16 A. Nothing that was pertinent to the case.

17 Q. And you filled out those four-page FDLE forms with  
18 the information that you gathered?

19 A. Correct.

20 Q. What else did you do on the 2nd?

21 A. We canvassed a street, I believe it was called  
22 East Bay Drive.

23 Q. The dumpsters?

24 A. It was dumpsters and properties on the north side  
25 of East Bay Drive.

1 Q. Did you find anything?

2 A. No.

3 Q. What else did you do on the 2nd?

4 A. We responded to 501 East Bay Drive. That's where  
5 there were dumpsters located at the Magnolia Square  
6 Condominiums complex.

7 Q. Did you search the Magnolia Square Condominiums  
8 complex?

9 A. We searched the dumpsters on that property.

10 Q. Find anything?

11 A. No, ma'am.

12 Q. Anything else on the 2nd?

13 A. Yes. We responded to City of Largo Recycling  
14 Center at 1551 Starkey Road.

15 Q. Rake through trash?

16 A. Yes.

17 Q. Find anything?

18 A. Nothing pertinent to the case.

19 Q. Anything else on the September 2nd?

20 A. No.

21 Q. Anything on September 3rd?

22 A. No.

23 Q. That would have been a Monday.

24 A. No.

25 Q. On the 4th?

1 A. Yes.

2 Q. What did you do on the 4th?

3 A. We were recalled, as part of the CART team, and we  
4 were asked to re-deploy to the Starkey recycling center.

5 Q. Rake through trash?

6 A. Correct.

7 Q. Find anything?

8 A. No.

9 Q. Then what did you do?

10 A. Then we were re-deployed to the Imperial Palms on  
11 Keene Road.

12 Q. Speak to the tenants at the Imperial Palms?

13 A. Yes, we did.

14 Q. Similarly, did you make note of who you spoke to?

15 A. Yes, we did.

16 Q. Anybody have any information reference this case?

17 A. No, ma'am.

18 Q. Then what did you do?

19 A. We were notified that the child was located.

20 Q. Did you do anything once Jordan's body was found?

21 A. No, not for the CART deploy.

22 Q. Was there something else?

23 A. No. We just went back to the office.

24 Q. Okay.

25 Anything else involvement?
