ORDER OF CONTINUANCE AND RESCHEDULING RETURN HEARING

It having come to the attention of this Court that one or both parties have demonstrated good cause to warrant a continuance of the return hearing in this cause and

- Petitioner appeared with counsel Alan J. Perlman, Esq via Zoom
- Respondent appeared via Zoom with counsel J. Kevin Hayslett, Esq
- Parties stipulated in open court in writing;

it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Temporary Injunction Without Notice entered herein shall remain in full force and effect until further Order of this Court. It is further ordered that the Clerk of Court shall immediately forward a copy of this Order together with a copy of the Temporary Injunction Without Notice, to the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office

OR

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Petition for Temporary Injunction was DENIED previously and remains as such.

It is further **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that:

1. The return hearing on the Petition for Injunction for Protection Against Violence shall be rescheduled before the assigned Judge. The party or its representing counsel for whom this Order of Continuance is being granted shall be responsible for rescheduling the return hearing before the assigned judge as soon as possible;

OR

2. The return hearing on the Petition for Injunction for Protection Against Violence shall be rescheduled by the Clerk of the Circuit Court on the next available regular Domestic Violence Court (DVI) or Repeat/Stalking (RVI) calendar.

OR


3. The return hearing on the Petition for Injunction for Protection Against Violence shall be heard on:

4. Other: Via Zoom in Courtroom to be determined.

INJUNCTION INFORMATION SHEET

1. Option to Appear Via Zoom

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Courts are undertaking very significant measures to ensure for the health of everyone involved in the court system. Statutes, due process, and The Florida Supreme Court require that the return hearings on domestic, dating, sexual, repeat violence and stalking injunctions be scheduled on an expedited basis. Your injunction case has been set for a return hearing as indicated in the paperwork you have received.

PLEASE NOTE: Although you may personally appear for this hearing and bring any witnesses and evidence with you, you also have the option to appear via Zoom.

To appear via Zoom, you may use your smartphone, tablet, or PC to access the Zoom meeting (your hearing). You must identify yourself in the Zoom platform using the name as it appears in the case. If you do not identify yourself properly, you may not be associated with the correct case and you may miss your hearing.

Should you wish to appear via Zoom, please notify our DV Office in Pinellas County at least two days prior to the hearing via email at [**DVEVIDENCE@jud6.org**](mailto:DVEVIDENCE@jud6.org). Please include the following in your email:

1. **Your Case Number** (This can be found in the upper right hand corner of most documents.)
2. **Your Name**
3. **Date and Time of Your Hearing**
4. **Your Phone Number** (The Court will only use this number to contact you in the event we are unable to see or hear you via the Zoom platform. It is important that you provide us with your phone number in the event there are issues with the Zoom connection.)

Evidence:

If you opt to appear via Zoom, **you must** submit any evidence you intend to present at the return hearing, such as emails, texting correspondence, photographs, police reports, etc., to the same email address, [**DVEVIDENCE@jud6.org**](mailto:DVEVIDENCE@jud6.org). Evidence must be emailed to our DV office at least two days prior to the hearing.

Witnesses:

Any witnesses you plan to call at your hearing may also appear via Zoom using the same Zoom conference number and password. They must also identify themselves in the Zoom platform using their name and the identifier “Witness for [party name]” (example: John Doe, Witness for Jane Smith)

2. Procedure when a Motion is Filed

When you file any motions with the clerk please send a copy to the Court at:

[**DVMotions@jud6.org**](mailto:DVMotions@jud6.org). Examples of these are a Motion to Continue your hearing to a later date, Motion to Dismiss Injunction, Motion to Modify Injunction, Motion to Extend Injunction, or Motion to Establish Timesharing.

So that the Court can hear the motions on an expedited basis, please include:

1. Your name
2. Your case number
3. A copy of your motion
4. Your contact information
5. Last known contact information of the other party
6. Any upcoming court dates that are already scheduled
