The Defendant, Mr. Cornelius Whitfield, files the following reciprocal evidence and witnesses as follows:

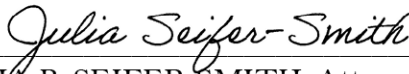
1. Defense Witnesses:
