At any point did you, maybe not this 13 14 night but on any subsequent nights, have any contact with Derek Green [sic] either in the hospital or after he was 15 16 released? 17 Not that I'm aware of. 18 Okay. Darren Barnes, the individual who was Q 19 killed, did you -- as far as you know, have you ever any 20 contact with him? 21 I don't believe so. Α 22 Did you do any research on that apartment number Q to see if there were any -- if that was a problem unit or 23 anything like that? 24

Q Okay. What was your responsibility in responding out to the scene?

A Basically, my job is just to oversee what's going on. We have a sergeant that's on the scene. That was Sergeant Marklin. She was responsible for making sure the scene was secure. My job is making sure that her job is being done. It was being done. And then I was responsible for notifications, which means I call our Major Crimes Unit, who I believe in the report I listed as Sergeant Elizondo, and notify them, hey, we have a scene with a deceased person and see if they want to respond to investigate.

Q Okay. At that time in February of '21, would you have had any role in either organizing the SWAT Team for any purpose, like calling out the SWAT Team or issuing them any, I guess, tasks or investigations?

A Not in regards to this case, no.

Q Who -- I guess whose job is that? Who gets to say, Come on, SWAT, we're going?

A There is a few different avenues. As a watch commander, I could do it if there was an emergency situation. Like let's say we have a hostage situation, and we need immediate activation of the SWAT Team. And then there's other ways. You go through the chain of command who oversees the SWAT Team. I'm not sure who was

in charge of the SWAT Team at that time, so I couldn't tell you an exact name.

Q Okay.

A But we do have a SWAT Team commander that all requests go through.

Q Did anybody ever contact you in the day or two after your supplement, which is February 2nd of '21? Did anybody contact you in the next couple of days, you know, and talk to you about activating the SWAT Team for Mr. Whitfield?

A Not that I recall.

Q And after you arrived that night or early morning and essentially oversee, I guess, the assignments as they're given out, do you have any subsequent or follow-up involvement?

A No. I just would probably check in with the supervisors and make sure that the scene is secure, that everything is going according to plan and see if they need anything. I'm also responsible for the rest of the City. So we could have other events going on that I'm also responsible for. So as long as the sergeant that's in charge and Major Crimes if they're on scene, if they're satisfied with everything, I have very little involvement, other than checking in to make sure they're okay.
