The Grand Jurors of the State of Florida, impaneled and sworn to inquire and true charge make in and for the body of the County of Pinellas, upon their oath do charge that

CORNELIUS WHITFIELD

in the County of Pinellas and State of Florida, on the 16th day of February, in the year of our Lord, two thousand twenty-one, in the County and State aforesaid unlawfully and from a premeditated design to effect the death of Sallie Whitfield, did shoot the said Sallie Whitfield with a firearm, and as a direct result thereof, the said Sallie Whitfield died; and during the course of the commission of the offense, CORNELIUS WHITFIELD did actually possess and discharge a firearm and as a result of the discharge, death was inflicted upon Sallie Whitfield; contrary to Chapter 782.04(1)(a)/775.087(1)/775.087(2)(a)3, Florida Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida. [L2]

COUNT TWO

And the Grand Jurors of the State of Florida, impaneled and sworn to inquire and true charge make in and for the body of the County of Pinellas, upon their oath do charge that CORNELIUS WHITFIELD, in the County of Pinellas, State of Florida, on the 16th day of February, in the year of our Lord, two thousand twenty-one, in the County and State aforesaid, unlawfully and from a premeditated design to effect the death of Patricia Sharpe, did shoot the said Patricia Sharpe with a firearm, and as a direct result thereof, the said Patricia Sharpe died; and during the course of the commission of the offense, CORNELIUS WHITFIELD did actually possess and discharge a firearm and as a result of the discharge, death was inflicted upon Patricia Sharpe; contrary to Chapter 782.04(1)(a)/775.087(1)/775.087(2)(a)3, Florida Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida. [L2]

COUNT THREE

And the Grand Jurors of the State of Florida, impaneled and sworn to inquire and true charge make in and for the body of the County of Pinellas, upon their oath do charge that CORNELIUS WHITFIELD, in the County of Pinellas, State of Florida, on the 16th day of February, in the year of our Lord, two thousand twenty-one, in the County and State aforesaid, unlawfully and from a premeditated design to effect the death of Antonio Graham, did shoot the said Antonio Graham with a firearm, and as a direct result thereof, the said Antonio Graham died; and during the course of the commission of the offense, CORNELIUS WHITFIELD did actually possess and discharge a firearm and as a result of the discharge, death was inflicted upon Antonio Green; contrary to Chapter 782.04(1)(a)/775.087(1)/775.087(2)(a)3, Florida Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida. [L2]

COUNT FOUR

And the Grand Jurors of the State of Florida, impaneled and sworn to inquire and true charge make in and for the body of the County of Pinellas, upon their oath do charge that CORNELIUS WHITFIELD, in the County of Pinellas, State of Florida, on the 16th day of February, in the year of our Lord, two thousand twenty-one, in the County and State aforesaid, unlawfully and from a premeditated design to effect the death of Shirleylene Harilal, did attempt to kill her by shooting her with a firearm thereby knowingly or intentionally causing great bodily harm or permanent disability or permanent disfigurement to her person; and during the course of the commission of the offense, CORNELIUS WHITFIELD did actually possess and discharge a firearm and as a result of the discharge, great bodily harm was inflicted upon Shirleylene Harilal; contrary to Chapter 782.04(1)(a)/777.04/ 784.045/775.087(1)/775.087(2)(a)3, Florida Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida. 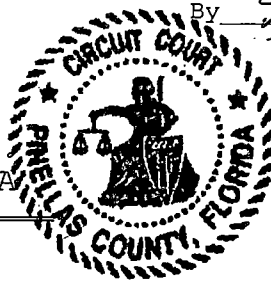
