ROBERT HOLZAEPFEL

in the County of Pinellas and State of Florida, on the 17th day of February, in the year of our Lord, two thousand twenty-one, unlawfully, while engaged in the perpetration of, or in an attempt to perpetrate the felony offense of Fleeing or Eluding, did, without any design to effect death, inflicted blunt force trauma to Michael Magli with a motor vehicle, and as a direct result thereof, Michael Magli, a law enforcement officer engaged in lawful performance of legal duty, died; contrary to Chapter 782.04(4)/782.065, Florida Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida. COUNT TWO

And the State Attorney aforesaid, under oath as aforesaid, further information makes that ROBERT HOLZAEPFEL, in the County of Pinellas, State of Florida, on the 17th day of February, in the year of our Lord, two thousand twenty-one, did unlawfully cause or contribute to causing the death of Michael Magli, a human being, by the operation of a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcoholic beverages and/or a substance controlled by Florida Statutes, Ch. 893, cocaine and was affected to the extent that his normal faculties were impaired or had a blood or breath alcohol level of .08 or more; contrary to Chapter 316.193(3)(c)3.a., Florida Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida. COUNT THREE

And the State Attorney aforesaid, under oath as aforesaid, further information makes that ROBERT HOLZAEPPFEL, in the County of Pinellas, State of Florida, on the 17th day of February, in the year of our Lord, two thousand twenty-one, did knowingly and unlawfully drive a motor vehicle upon the highways of this State during a time period when his driver's license or driving privilege had been canceled, suspended, or revoked; the said ROBERT HOLZAEPPFEL having been twice previously convicted of Driving While License Suspended or Revoked on January 19, 2018 and September 9, 2014 and/or March 4, 2008; contrary to Chapter 322.34(2)(c), Florida Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.
