JUAN ARIEL MOLINA-SALLES


in the County of Pinellas and State of Florida, on the 22nd day of September, in the year of our Lord, two thousand twenty-two, was the driver of a vehicle which was involved in a crash involving the death of [REDACTED] a vulnerable road user, and the said JUAN ARIEL MOLINA-SALLES did willfully fail to stop the vehicle at the scene of the crash or, as close thereto as possible, or remain at the scene of the crash until he had fulfilled the requirements of Florida Statute 316.062, to-wit: did not give his name and address, and the registration number of the vehicle he was driving, and did not render reasonable assistance to persons injured in the crash; and caused the death of [REDACTED] contrary to Chapter 316.027(2)(c)/316.027(2)(f)/921.0021(7)(e), Florida Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.
