You hadn't had any conversation with him that 23 0 day or anything like that? 24

The last time I talked to him was probably

1 | a week or two prior to that.

Q And then what happened? You got the call. Where did you go?

A I was down in Squad 1, so I was near 54th Avenue and 275. So I hopped on 275 and started going north. By the time I got there, I think it was Deputy Hirshman called it out on the radio that they needed -- he basically said that Hartwick was deceased -- or sorry, not deceased. At the time, FD was working with him, but he needed all of northbound or southbound traffic shut down. So I just continued, went underneath the underpass. Just before the bridge, you can go underneath. And then from there, I moved down to Ulmerton and 275 area and shut off traffic from there.

Q Okay. So you never actually went to the scene where Deputy Hartwick was?

A No, not until after Mr. -- sorry, I don't remember his name. He was arrested. I never actually went to the scene still after that.

Q Okay. So you just proceeded -- maintained the position to shut down traffic?

A I went from there, and then after, Tampa PD came across to help. From there I went down to the north end of the scene, but I wasn't really near the scene because I was -- yeah, because I was like basically acting as a

control point. So, yeah, that's really about as close as 1 2 I got. 3 And were you kind of listening to traffic on the 0 radio and that sort of thing? 4 Yeah. We were basically letting the detectives 5 as they were coming on scene through and making sure that 6 no one else got on scene. 7 8 And then at some point you learned that the 9 suspect, Mr. Molina-Salles was in custody? 10 Yes. We had the bloodhound come from Pasco. the time, I think it was Corporal Aitken. I remember 11 watching because the sun was coming up. They were like 12 going along the fence. They said they got him on the 13 14 radio. I went down there. We placed him in the back of 15 my cruiser. Did you -- how far were you from the area where 16 0 17 he was apprehended? 18 From the north end of the scene to wherever the 19 on-ramp from Ulmerton or Roosevelt, whatever that one was. 20 I don't know the exact distance on that. I'm sorry. 21 Do you -- if you know, how far -- where he was Q 22 apprehended, how far was that from the traffic accident? 23 Not far. Α And he was apprehended by bloodhound I think you 24 Q 25 said?

Bloodhound from Pasco. 1 Α 2 Did you see the apprehension, or you were far Q 3 away from that? 4 I was far away from that. 5 And how was it -- did somebody order you to go Q to transport him, or did you go on your own? How was it 6 that you were the one to go to pick him up? 7 8 I just went on my own because I knew that -- I 9 watched them go and kind of go off into the distance, and then basically, as soon as they call out, it's like, all 10 11 right, someone has to go. It was either me or someone 12 else I think that was close. I think there was another 13 deputy that was somewhat close. Basically, he ended up 14 going in my cruiser. 15 Q Deputy Mattox? 16 No, that was later. 17 Oh, okay. Do you remember who the other deputy Q 18 was? 19 Lira-Rangel. I think he was behind me as I was Α going to go where the K-9 deputies were. 20 21 And so was Mr. Molina-Salles already in handcuffs when you got there? 22 23 Α Yes. Okay.
