CASE TYPE:

- Summary post conviction appeal. An electronic bookmarked record is being transmitted to the Florida Courts E-Filing Portal contemporaneously with the notice of appeal.
- Summary post conviction appeal. The electronic record cannot be transmitted at this time but will follow within days.
- Non summary post conviction appeal. The lower tribunal clerk HAS treated the notice of appeal as a designation to the court reporter.
- Judgment and sentence appeal.
- Juvenile delinquency appeal.
- State criminal appeal.
- Dependency/termination of parental rights appeal.
- Other civil appeal, including probate/guardianship, Ryce, Baker Act, etc.
- Administrative appeal.
- Criminal appeal of unknown case classification. A copy of the order that seems to be appealed is included in this transmission, or it is impossible to determine what order the appellant is attempting to appeal.


