**DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORIZATION OF FUNDS
FOR CONFIDENTIAL FORENSIC NEUROPSYCHOLOGIST**

COMES NOW, the Defendant, TOMASZ KOSOWSKI, by and through his undersigned attorney, DANIEL M. HERNANDEZ, and moves this Honorable Court for the appointment of a confidential forensic neuropsychologist to assist the Defendant in the above cause.

As grounds for said Motion, the following is alleged:

1. On June 18, 2026, this Court entered an Order Appointing Forensic Neuropsychologist authorizing compensation at the rate of \$300.00 per hour, travel time at \$125.00 per hour, with an initial authorization of \$15,000.00, to be paid through the Justice Administrative Commission.
2. Defendant remains indigent and continues to require the services of the confidential forensic neuropsychologist in the preparation of the defense.
3. This case involves complex issues concerning the Defendant's mental condition and the potential presentation of a Not Guilty by Reason of Insanity defense. The services required include review of extensive records, testing, clinical interviews, collateral interviews, consultation with counsel, report preparation, trial preparation, and testimony if necessary.
4. Due to the complexity of this case and the scope of work required, the initial

authorization has been exhausted or will soon be exhausted. Additional expert funding is reasonably necessary.

5. Defendant requests supplemental authorization of an additional Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00).
6. Defendant further requests clarification that the expert may bill professional services at \$300.00 per hour, reasonable and necessary travel time at \$125.00 per hour, and reasonable and necessary travel expenses, including mileage, airfare, lodging, parking, tolls, meals when applicable, and other reasonable travel expenses, consistent with JAC policies.

WHEREFORE, Defendant respectfully requests that this Court authorize an additional \$15,000.00 in expert funds; clarify the authorized travel compensation; direct payment through the Justice Administrative Commission; and grant such other relief as is just and proper.
