1 **P R O C E E D I N G S**

2 THE COURT: We are going to talk about
3 Mr. Mosley.

4 Can we have Mr. Mosley out, please?

5 THE BAILIFF: Yes, your Honor.

6 THE COURT: All right. Mr. Mosley is present
7 in Court.

8 Good morning.

9 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: Good morning.

10 Julia Seifer-Smith and Margaret Russell,
11 Assistant Public Defenders on behalf of Mr. Thomas
12 Mosley who is present before the Court.

13 THE COURT: Okay. What is our status today?

14 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: We are proceeding with
15 discovery and with our mitigation investigation.
16 We have had, I think, a couple rounds of
17 depositions. We have more set. Everything is
18 proceeding at pace.

19 THE COURT: Okay. Anything to add?

20 MS. SULLIVAN: No, your Honor. We have two
21 rounds of depositions set in April.

22 Courtney Sullivan for the State.

23 We -- Ms. Seifer-Smith and I -- I brought up
24 to her yesterday -- there were warrants done in
25 this case. The affidavits are sealed. I do not

1 recall that we ever unsealed them. So I had asked
2 if she wanted to move the Court to do that so I can
3 get her the full affidavits. Right now she only
4 has the warrants and any returns that were filed.

5 THE COURT: Okay.

6 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: That's correct.

7 Would your Honor entertain an oral motion this
8 morning?

9 THE COURT: I will.

10 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: I believe it's three
11 warrants.

12 MS. SULLIVAN: It's four.

13 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: Four.

14 THE COURT: And what --

15 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: And we would move for the
16 full affidavits to be unsealed.

17 THE COURT: What are they?

18 MS. SULLIVAN: So there is -- for an iPhone,
19 the defendant's iPhone. There was a body warrant
20 done to process Mr. Mosley with the Pinellas
21 County Jail, search warrant of his parents'
22 residence, and the last one was, the digital video
23 recorder from inside the residence of his parents.

24 THE COURT: Okay. So I will unseal all four
25 of those, so you can discover them over to

1 defense.

2 MS. SULLIVAN: Yes.

3 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: Thank you.

4 THE COURT: All right. So depositions are --
5 everything that you have set is set in April? Do
6 you want me to give you something in late May and
7 you can then give me an idea of where you are at?
8 Does that work for everybody?

9 MS. SULLIVAN: Yes.

10 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: I mean, I think we have
11 been doing an okay job of setting depositions like
12 as -- as we have been going. So if your Honor
13 wouldn't mind putting us out a little further in
14 June or even in July?

15 THE COURT: Are you okay with that?

16 MS. SULLIVAN: Yes, I am.

17 THE COURT: All right. So tell me when you
18 want your next court date then, June or July?

19 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: Maybe the end of June,
20 early July.

21 THE COURT: June 25, does that work for
22 everybody?

23 MS. SULLIVAN: It works for the State.

24 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: That works for us, I
25 think.

1 MS. RUSSELL: Yes.

2 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: Yes, that works for us.

3 THE COURT: Okay. June 25 for a pretrial.

4 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: Great.

5 THE COURT: See you then. Thank you.
