ORDER FOR NO CONTACT WITH VICTIM


The foregoing cause coming on this day to be heard upon the Defendant's Motion for Pretrial Release and/or Bond, the same having been argued by counsel for the respective parties and duly considered by the Court, the Court makes the following findings as a condition of pretrial release and/or bond.

1. The defendant **must** refrain from **any** contact of any type with **WITH THE VICTIM'S NEXT OF KIN**, further referenced to as the victim(s) except through pretrial discovery pursuant to the Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure.
2. An order of no contact precludes communicating orally or in any written form, either in person, telephonically, electronically, including texting, posting, Facebook, or Twitter, or in any other manner, either directly or indirectly through a third person, with the victim(s).
3. The defendant is prohibited from having physical or violent contact with the victim or his or her property.
4. The defendant is prohibited from being within **500 feet** of the victim.
5. The defendant is prohibited from being within **500 feet** of the victim's residence, even if the defendant and the victim share the residence, victim's vehicle, place of employment, or a specified place frequented regularly by such person.

This order of no contact is effective immediately, regardless of whether Defendant is in custody or on pretrial release, and enforceable for the duration of Defendant's pretrial incarceration and pretrial release, or until it is modified by the court.
