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THE DEFENDANT THOMAS ISAIAH MOSLEY:**

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THE COURT: Is everyone here for Mosley?

MS. MANUEL: Yes, your Honor.

THE COURT: I thought I saw everybody. Add-on motions.

Can we have Mr. Mosley out, please?

THE BAILIFF: Your Honor, Mr. Mosley is not brought over yet. He's a psych.

THE COURT: Why?

THE BAILIFF: Special order.

THE COURT: Okay. Mr. Mosley's not here.

MS. MANUEL: We're fine waiving his presence, your Honor, if the Court is.

THE COURT: This is a problem. This is every day this happens now. I'm not -- you're the messenger, I understand, but this is a serious problem. Every day we have to go through this.

THE BAILIFF: I can get him ordered, your Honor.

THE COURT: Right, but it's gonna be what, an hour before he gets here? Okay.

All right. You requested a continuance of the 3/22 hearing, correct?

MS. MANUEL: Correct, your Honor. When we -- when we set it on 3/22, I had told the Court

1 when we initially set it and then when we came back
2 for the status check, as well, that was part of the
3 reason we had set the status check was to see if I
4 was going to be in another murder trial in a
5 different division starting that following week,
6 and so we double-booked me with -- but I let
7 everybody know that that was a potential conflict.

8 THE COURT: Yeah, I know. Yeah.

9 MS. MANUEL: Judge Helinger did deny our
10 request to continue that case. So I am unavailable
11 for the 3/22 date.

12 THE COURT: What says the State?

13 MS. SULLIVAN: The State is objecting to
14 moving the hearing. As I stated previously, this
15 report from the State Hospital is dated towards the
16 beginning of January. We made arrangements for the
17 doctor to testify in person. She's scheduled to
18 fly in Friday morning and fly out Friday evening.
19 That flight has already been booked.

20 From my understanding, Ms. Manuel's trial
21 starts the following Tuesday. She's not actually
22 in trial on Friday. I understand she has trial
23 prep, but we would be objecting, and we'd like to
24 get at least this doctor's testimony on the record
25 this Friday so the report does not get stale.

1 We had already decided to bifurcate the
2 hearing and have the remaining of any doctors the
3 Defense wanted to put in set out in June. So we
4 are objecting to continuing the hearing on Friday.

5 THE COURT: So you already bought the tickets?

6 MS. SULLIVAN: Yes.

7 THE COURT: Okay. My thought would be to put
8 it on for Thursday and see what's happening with
9 your trial. Is there any likelihood of that
10 working out?

11 MS. MANUEL: Well, we're going to file -- so
12 when we had addressed the continuance a couple
13 weeks ago when I emailed everybody, it actually was
14 not on the record. So we're going in this morning
15 to put it on the record so that we can file a
16 request with the Second to stay, but I don't know
17 what -- I don't know what they will do.

18 THE COURT: Okay. I'd like to check back then
19 later this week and see how that's panning out.

20 THE BAILIFF: Your Honor, Ms. Mosley is
21 downstairs.

22 THE COURT: Okay. Well, we're already halfway
23 through the hearing.

24 So you want to check back with me March 20th
25 in the morning, tell me where you're at?

1 MS. MANUEL: Sure. Wednesday; is that right?

2 THE COURT: Yes, please.

3 MS. MANUEL: Okay.

4 THE COURT: And then if you-all want to
5 communicate what happens with Judge Helinger's
6 trial between now and then, that would be helpful
7 and we'll go from there.

8 MS. MANUEL: Okay.

9 THE COURT: Okay. What page was he on the
10 calendar?

11 MS. SULLIVAN: It was on 4 of 6 on the motions
12 calendar.

13 THE COURT: Okay. So that will be reset to
14 March 20th, 8:45.

15 THE CLERK: On Wednesday?

16 THE COURT: Please. All right. Okay. See
17 you then.

18 MS. MANUEL: Thank you, your Honor.
