MS. MANUEL: Judge Helinger did deny our request to continue that case. So I am unavailable for the 3/22 date.

MS. SULLIVAN: The State is objecting to moving the hearing. As I stated previously, this report from the State Hospital is dated towards the beginning of January. We made arrangements for the doctor to testify in person. She's scheduled to fly in Friday morning and fly out Friday evening. That flight has already been booked.

From my understanding, Ms. Manuel's trial starts the following Tuesday. She's not actually in trial on Friday. I understand she has trial prep, but we would be objecting, and we'd like to get at least this doctor's testimony on the record this Friday so the report does not get stale.

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We had already decided to bifurcate the hearing and have the remaining of any doctors the Defense wanted to put in set out in June. So we are objecting to continuing the hearing on Friday.

THE COURT: So you already bought the tickets?

MS. SULLIVAN: Yes.

THE COURT: Okay. My thought would be to put it on for Thursday and see what's happening with your trial. Is there any likelihood of that working out?

MS. MANUEL: Well, we're going to file -- so when we had addressed the continuance a couple weeks ago when I emailed everybody, it actually was not on the record. So we're going in this morning to put it on the record so that we can file a request with the Second to stay, but I don't know what -- I don't know what they will do.

THE COURT: Okay. I'd like to check back then later this week and see how that's panning out.

THE BAILIFF: Your Honor, Ms. Mosley is downstairs.

THE COURT: Okay. Well, we're already halfway through the hearing.

So you want to check back with me March 20th in the morning, tell me where you're at?
