2	THE COURT: All right. Is Mosley up and
3	ready?
4	MS. SEIFER-SMITH: Yes, your Honor, he is.
5	THE BAILIFF: Yes, your Honor.
6	THE COURT: All right. And then we'll
7	address Mr. Kingos next.
8	All right. Mr. Mosley is present in
9	Court, and so today I believe we just set a
10	status check to see where everyone was at as it
11	relates to being prepared for the competency
12	evidentiary hearing set in June I have
13	June the whole week of June 14th blocked
14	off.
15	So what is our status today?
16	MS. SULLIVAN: I think we were July 8th
17	through 11th.
18	THE COURT: That might be accurate.
19	MS. SEIFER-SMITH: July 8th.
20	THE COURT: Thank you. Let me make sure I
21	put it on my calendar correctly. Yes, July
22	8th. You are right.
23	What is our status today?
24	MS. RUSSELL: Good morning, your Honor.
25	THE COURT: Good morning.

1 MS. RUSSELL: It's Margaret Russell and 2 Julia Seifer-Smith on behalf of Thomas Mosley. 3 He is on page six of three of your motion 4 calendar this morning. 5 We have been working hard, getting the 6 Court appointed experts through. I believe Dr. 7 Railey completed his evaluation. He still has 8 some collateral interviews to follow up on, and 9 we expect his report to be complete some time, 10 I hope, in the next ten days or so. 11 THE COURT: Okay. 12 MS. RUSSELL: Dr. Torrealday was only able 13 to complete half of her evaluation. She needs 14 to come back and do some more testing. 15 THE COURT: Okay. 16 MS. RUSSELL: I did reach out to her 17 earlier this week and I have not heard back 18 either on the date that she intends to return 19 or on her availability for July. 20 THE COURT: Okay. 21 MS. RUSSELL: I do know generally she is 2.2 out of the county for the entire month of July. 23 We are trying to find some other potential 24 dates, either in June or in August when she 25 might be available, but I don't have a response

1 from her yet. 2 THE COURT: Okay. 3 MS. RUSSELL: We do know that Dr. Railey 4 is available on the week of July 8th. 5 THE COURT: Okay. 6 MS. RUSSELL: Dr. McClain is also 7 available that week. Dr. Hall unfortunately has two trials. One is scheduled in St. Louis. 8 9 They are civil trials, however. So we will be 10 third in line in the case that those get 11 resolved or get moved. 12 THE COURT: Okay. 13 MS. RUSSELL: Otherwise, he did give me 14 five other dates when he might be available for 15 three or four hours of testimony in an 16 afternoon if the Court wanted to block that off 17 now or if you wanted to just see what happens. 18 THE COURT: So he can't make any of those 19 days work? 20 MS. RUSSELL: Right, because he is 21 basically double -- he is double scheduled to 2.2 testify in two civil trials. One of them is in 23 St. Louis. And so he is not really sure how he 24 could make it work. He said -- he did tell me, 25 however, though that if they either settle or

1	if it's he's testifying on a Tuesday, that
2	he could be available on a Thursday, that he
3	would absolutely try to do whatever he could to
4	make it.
5	THE COURT: Okay. That is my hope.
6	How are you looking for witnesses?
7	MS. SULLIVAN: So the doctor from the
8	treatment center, I spoke with her and I told
9	her the four dates that we had blocked off.
10	THE COURT: Okay.
11	MS. SULLIVAN: Her preference is to do
12	Friday afternoon because she would have to be
13	coming from the Miami-ish area. So I wanted to
14	clear that with you before I set up travel for
15	her on a Friday.
16	THE COURT: I have I have 8, 9, 10 and
17	11 blocked off.
18	MS. SULLIVAN: I figured you
19	THE COURT: I am not doing anything else
20	other than this.
21	MS. SULLIVAN: So if you are okay with the
22	11th for her
23	THE COURT: Yes.
24	MS. SULLIVAN: I'll lock her in for
25	that date.

1	THE COURT: Sure.
2	MS. SULLIVAN: When we went over to the
3	eval with Dr. Torrealday before Mr. Mosley
4	asked us to leave, Dr. Torrealday did say that
5	even though she is gone in July, she can do it
6	earlier. So I think we will be able to work
7	with Dr. Torrealday, to have the date, but
8	unfortunately it probably won't be one of the
9	four days you have blocked off.
10	So right now we don't know who is
11	obviously, other than Dr. Hall and McClain for
12	the defense, we don't know where the Court
13	appointed doctors who they will be
14	testifying for yet.
15	THE COURT: Okay.
16	MS. SULLIVAN: And we also have been in
17	good communication with the Court appointed
18	doctors to get them any information, and I know
19	that the defense has as well, that we would
20	like them to review, and they have been very
21	open to receiving any information that we want
22	to provide. So they are working on that as
23	well.
24	THE COURT: Okay. So it was
25	Dr. Torrealday that might need the earlier

1 date? 2 MS. SULLIVAN: Yes. 3 THE COURT: Is that right? 4 MS. SULLIVAN: Yes. 5 THE COURT: And maybe Dr. Hall? 6 MS. RUSSELL: Right, although he actually 7 doesn't have anything beforehand. What I have 8 from him are dates in July and August, 9 unfortunately, but if there is another date, I 10 will run it up the flagpole and see if I can 11 get him to come. 12 Yeah. All right. I mean, I'm THE COURT: 13 going to have to cancel someone else's hearing. 14 I'm fine doing that. This is a death penalty 15 case with a competency issue that needs to be resolved in certain timeframes. 16 17 So my expectation is if we can't get 18 everything done in the four days that I have 19 blocked off, for everybody to present their 20 witnesses and have argument, it's my 21 expectation to do it sooner. So -- and I'm 2.2 fine doing that. I'm going to have to cancel 23 someone else's hearings or cancel someone 24 else's trials to do that. I just need a date 25 specific from you-all. It's not what's good

1 for me. I'm going to move stuff around to make 2 it happen. So I need a date from you-all that 3 is going to work, and we will have it that day. 4 So if you want to reach out to whoever is 5 having a scheduling problem, let me know when 6 you want to do it, and I will schedule it for 7 that time. 8 MS. RUSSELL: So, your Honor, we are happy 9 to be in touch with our experts and do the best 10 we can to do that, but, of course, we do need 11 all the Court appointed experts' reports 12 completed and in before we can schedule that. 13 That's why I blocked off four THE COURT: 14 days in hopes that we would be able to get 15 every expert in here that week. I would hope 16 they would understand the same thing I do. 17 This is a death penalty case and we operate 18 under timeframes.

So to the extent other people can rearrange their schedule to make it happen, that would make me really pleased. With the understanding if they can't, they can't, and I'll accommodate, but sooner rather than later, do the best you can, and then if we can't, we've got to do everything else that week in 9

1 July. Okay? 2 MS. RUSSELL: We'll try our best, your 3 Honor. 4 THE COURT: All right. I appreciate that. 5 Anything else we need to talk about for 6 Mr. Mosley today? 7 MS. SULLIVAN: For the treatment center 8 doctor, just for timing. Are you okay with 9 starting at one on the 11th? 10 THE COURT: I have the entire day blocked 11 off. 12 MS. SULLIVAN: Do you have VOPs in the 13 morning? THE COURT: I'm not setting anything else 14 15 that week. 16 MS. SULLIVAN: Okay. 17 THE COURT: This is my thing for the week, 18 Mr. Mosley. 19 MS. SULLIVAN: I can try and have her --20 if we start earlier Friday, because I'm trying 21 to think if we have got to go into argument --22 I don't even know if we will be done with all 23 the witnesses by that Friday with the 24 scheduling. 25 THE COURT: I would hope so. I would hope

1 so. The best we can do it, earlier is better 2 than later. I don't think we want to be here 3 like we were here the last time, until six, 4 seven o'clock at night, whatever time. 5 MS. SULLIVAN: I'm going to have her get 6 here as early as she can on Friday, even if she 7 flies in Thursday night, so that we can not be 8 here super late on Friday. 9 THE COURT: Okay. I'm happy to start 10 first thing in the morning on Friday. You tell 11 me. As we get closer, you-all tell me who is 12 scheduled for what dates and times and we'll 13 start at that date and time. 14 MS. RUSSELL: And just full disclosure, 15 your Honor, we expect the cross-examination of 16 Dr. Tenaglia (phonetic) to be lengthy --17 THE COURT: I'm sure. MS. RUSSELL: -- and complicated. 18 19 THE COURT: Which is why --20 MS. RUSSELL: Which is why I would also 21 prefer to start as early as possible. 22 I am with you. So let's try THE COURT: 23 to do that. 24 MS. SULLIVAN: Okay. 25 MS. RUSSELL: Okay.

1 THE COURT: So why don't I set a status 2 check maybe at the end of June, and I'm hoping 3 at that point you-all can give me a lineup of 4 who you are going to have testify on what day. And that way, you know, if there is a day that 5 6 you are not going to use of the 8th, 9th, 10th 7 and 11th, I can do other things. 8 MS. SULLIVAN: Okay. 9 MS. RUSSELL: Okay. 10 THE COURT: When do you think you are 11 going to have an answer from Torrealday or we 12 don't know? 13 MS. SULLIVAN: We can all reach out to her 14 together in a group email which she has become 15 accustomed to and check with her and get some 16 dates from her. 17 THE COURT: Okay. So for the -- for a 18 status check related to the week of July, let's 19 just have something the week of the 23rd -- 23, 20 24, 25, 26, to come in and we'll have a 21 pretrial and a status check on what days you 22 are going to call which witnesses. 23 MS. SULLIVAN: I'm okay the 24th or the 24 25. 25 MS. RUSSELL: Either one of those days

works for us, your Honor.

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2 THE COURT: All right. So let's do the 3 24th then. June 24th for pretrial and status 4 check, and then do you-all want to let me know 5 when Torrealday and Hall are available sooner, 6 or do you want me set something maybe in a week 7 or two? MS. SEIFER-SMITH: Well, I suppose if we 8 9 learn their availability sooner, than we can 10 reach out to your Honor sooner. 11 THE COURT: Okay. 12 MS. SULLIVAN: I can throw you in on the 13 group email chat. 14 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: I don't know that you 15 want to be on that. 16 THE COURT: I probably don't. 17 MS. SULLIVAN: You don't. 18 THE COURT: I probably don't. Okay. So 19 I'll just leave it at you-all are going to 20 contact me when you have a date certain for 21 Hall and Torrealday, which seem to be the --22 the timing issues. 23 Okay. All right. Sounds good. Then I'll 24 see you-all -- what date did I give you -- June 25 24th.
