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P-R-O-C-E-E-D-I-N-G-S

THE COURT: Are we ready on Mr. Mosley? Do we have everybody here?

MS. RUSSELL: Yes.

THE COURT: Okay. Great. Can we have Mr. Mosley out, please.

THE BAILIFF: Yes, your Honor.

(THE DEFENDANT ENTERED THE COURTROOM)

THE COURT: All right. Mr. Mosley is present.

I think we're here today just for a status check, to make sure everybody's scheduled for the dates and times that we need to be scheduled for. Does that sound right?

MS. RUSSELL: Yes, your Honor.

THE COURT: So Jill put together a schedule. You all tell me if I'm accurate about this. I have -- this Thursday at 1:30, I have Dr. Fabian.

MS. RUSSELL: Yes, your Honor. Would you like us to comment now, or do you want us to wait till you finish?

THE COURT: Let me go through, and then you can tell me what I'm wrong about. And then I have July 8th, at 9:00 a.m., Dr. McClain; Wednesday, July 9th, Dr. Hall, at 9:00 a.m.; July 10th, Dr. Railey, at 9:00 a.m.; and Friday, July 11th,

1 Dr. Tenaglia, at 9:00 a.m.

2 Any comments now?

3 MS. RUSSELL: Yes, your Honor. First of all,
4 for the record, it's Margaret Russell and
5 Julia Seifer-Smith for Thomas Mosley, who is
6 present in the courtroom.

7 Starting with the 26th, I was in touch with
8 Dr. Fabian last night --

9 THE COURT: Okay.

10 MS. RUSSELL: -- and we all have a little bit
11 of a fear that his testimony may run a little
12 longer than anticipated, and he was curious if he
13 might start at 1:00.

14 THE COURT: Fine by me. I can start earlier
15 than that if you wanted to.

16 MS. RUSSELL: All right. Well, that leads
17 into my next question. He has a very peculiar
18 PowerPoint, and we don't really want to waste the
19 Court's time and everyone's time making sure all
20 the technology works. Is there a time when we can
21 slip into the courtroom at some point prior?

22 THE COURT: Anytime. If I'm in here handling
23 Thursday morning business, you all are welcome to
24 have IT help you make sure everything's running.
25 It's not gonna distract me.

1 MS. RUSSELL: Okay. That sounds good. We'll
2 be here Thursday morning.

3 THE COURT: Okay.

4 MS. SULLIVAN: Ms. Russell, how early do you
5 think Dr. Fabian could start then on Thursday?

6 MS. RUSSELL: 12:30.

7 THE COURT: I'm here for you guys. So you
8 tell me.

9 MS. SULLIVAN: I can start whenever after
10 9:30.

11 MS. RUSSELL: Okay.

12 THE COURT: That's fine by me. If you want
13 him to come in the morning, we could start after
14 the morning calendar. I just need to give everyone
15 a little time to eat at some point.

16 MS. RUSSELL: He did tell me that he
17 unfortunately has some other things that he has
18 scheduled that morning. I think he is in town, but
19 he's got some other things scheduled, and so I
20 think we could start as early as 12:30.

21 THE COURT: You all talk with him and talk to
22 each other and, if you want to start earlier, I'll
23 be ready to go earlier.

24 MS. RUSSELL: Excellent.

25 THE COURT: Okay. What about the rest of the

1 schedule? Did I get all that correct?

2 MS. RUSSELL: On the 8th, I think we probably
3 will start with Dr. McClain. We may have some
4 additional adaptive functioning witnesses after
5 Dr. McClain is through.

6 THE COURT: That's fine.

7 MS. RUSSELL: On the following day, which is
8 the 9th --

9 THE COURT: Yes.

10 MS. RUSSELL: -- we will have Dr. Hall
11 actually in the afternoon, and a new expert that
12 was listed, Dr. Amy Fritz, will testify in the
13 morning.

14 THE COURT: Okay. Dr. Amy Fritz?

15 MS. RUSSELL: Yes, F-R-I-T-Z. We listed
16 Dr. Fritz yesterday.

17 THE COURT: 9:00 a.m. And Dr. Hall's gonna be
18 at 1:30?

19 MS. RUSSELL: 1:30.

20 THE COURT: 1:30? 1:30 is fine.

21 Okay. What else?

22 MS. SULLIVAN: Dr Railey at 9:00 is good, and
23 Dr. Tenaglia at 9:00 is good.

24 THE COURT: Okay. Are you going -- go ahead.

25 MS. RUSSELL: Sorry, your Honor.

1 THE COURT: Go ahead.

2 MS. RUSSELL: We may also have some additional
3 short adaptive functioning witnesses that we may
4 fit in on Thursday and Friday, depending on how
5 things go.

6 THE COURT: If there's gonna be time after the
7 doctor testifies that you have other collateral
8 people that you want me to hear from, that's fine.

9 Are you gonna have anyone other than the
10 doctors?

11 MS. SULLIVAN: No.

12 THE COURT: Okay. Is there anything you all
13 want me to read in advance? I don't know if
14 Dr. Fritz authored a report. I don't know if you
15 want me to read it in advance. Dr. Hall, anybody,
16 I'll read them. If you don't want me to read them,
17 I won't read them, but if you want me to, please
18 email them, and I'll read them in advance.

19 MS. RUSSELL: It's likely that we will
20 probably file them under seal in the record, your
21 Honor, and we'll provide you copies.

22 THE COURT: Okay.

23 MS. RUSSELL: Unfortunately, with Dr. Fritz,
24 we only have a summary report which we provided to
25 the State. I think we expect her report will be

1 due before the July 4th weekend. So we should be
2 able to file it in time.

3 THE COURT: Okay.

4 MS. RUSSELL: In addition, Dr. Torrealday is a
5 little bit of a wildcard. We have all reached out,
6 including the State, to try to figure out when her
7 report might be due and when she might be able to
8 testify after she returns from overseas. We expect
9 that to be in August, but we still haven't
10 heard -- no one really has heard back from her in
11 terms of when we can expect a report or set a date.

12 MS. SULLIVAN: We had known that she was gonna
13 be gone all of July. I think we know that she did
14 the evaluation. She had some follow-up stuff she
15 wanted to do. So we were hoping to have a report
16 at least and then schedule her testimony for when
17 she's back, but we haven't heard anything.

18 THE COURT: Okay. All right. Well, I'm not
19 sure how to deal with that.

20 MS. SULLIVAN: We weren't either. We just
21 keep emailing her. We're just gonna keep emailing
22 her more this week, but I don't know.

23 THE COURT: Okay. All right. Well, keep me
24 updated as to whether or not either one of you hear
25 from her.

1 MS. SULLIVAN: Okay.

2 THE COURT: And I'll try and have some
3 thoughts on that for Thursday when we get together.
4 What time did we say we were gonna start? Do you
5 want to start at 12:30 on Thursday?

6 MS. RUSSELL: That's fine.

7 MS. SULLIVAN: Yeah.

8 THE COURT: Okay. Anything else we need to
9 talk about for today?

10 MS. SULLIVAN: I don't think so.

11 MS. RUSSELL: Not from the Defense, your
12 Honor.

13 THE COURT: All right. Thank you. I
14 appreciate you all getting the schedule together
15 for me, and I will see you on Thursday. Thank you.

16 MS. SULLIVAN: Thank you.
