PROCEEDINGS 1 2 THE COURT: Is Mr. Mosley on his way out? THE BAILIFF: Yes. 3 (MR. MOSLEY ENTERED THE COURTROOM) 4 5 THE COURT: All right. Mr. Mosley is 6 present. 7 All right. Good morning, Ms. Seifer-Smith. MS. SEIFER-SMITH: Good morning, your Honor. 8 9 Julia Seifer-Smith and Margaret Russell, on 10 behalf of Thomas Mosley. 11 THE COURT: All right.
