14 get our feet under us, and we'll communicate with  
15 the State about anything that may still be  
16 outstanding with regards to discovery, and  
17 hopefully get on the same page for scheduling  
18 depositions.

19 THE COURT: Okay. Any day of the week easier  
20 for you-all to come in?

21 MS. SULLIVAN: No. I just try to avoid  
22 Mondays because they're busy mornings.

23 THE COURT: They are busy mornings. Okay. So  
24 January 14 is a Wednesday. You want to do that?

25 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: Ms. Russell and I have a

1 trial with Judge Federico. So we could be here at  
2 8:30.

3 THE COURT: I can do --

4 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: Or we could do the week  
5 after.

6 THE COURT: I could do the 14th, 15th, 21st,  
7 22nd.

8 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: Let's do the 21st, if we  
9 could.

10 THE COURT: January 21 for pretrial.

11 MS. SEIFER-SMITH: Thank you.

12 THE COURT: Okay. Does that work for you-all?

13 MS. SULLIVAN: Yes, ma'am.

14 THE COURT: All right. January 21st for  
15 pretrial. See you then.

16 THE STATE: Thank you.

17 MS. RUSSELL: Thank you, your Honor.

18 THE COURT: The pretrial is January 21st of  
19 '26.

20 THE CLERK: '26, yeah. That's what I wanted  
21 to confirm.
