OBJECTION TO MOTION TO STRIKE

Comes Now, Plaintiff, Neelam Taneja Perry, candidate for US House of Representatives, Florida, District 14 files a complaint to **OBJECTION TO MOTION TO STRIKE**, and states grounds as follows:

1. The Defendant Julie Marcus and Amanda Coffey filed Motion to Strike during the hearing on September 9, 2024 at 2 p.m.

- 2. They presented an order which was overruled by filing A writ of Certiorari, which was then settled by an Agreed order of Release (Exhibit A) and was ratified by the lower court and then the writ was withdrawn as moot.
- 3. The Pinellas County docket (Exhibit B) shows that the order was overruled by the second DCA by the 'Agreed order of release. (Exhibit A).
- 4. However, the attorney for the Government officials, who have a responsibility to protect the public against deception, deliberately ignored the evidence to misrepresent the orders to mislead and manipulate this court in order to circumvent this complaint with the Evidence of Election Fraud that needs to be considered by your Honor.
- 5. This dishonest and disturbing misrepresentation is misconduct and fraud in court against the plaintiff and the citizens of district 14. These defendants have proven to the court that they are not ethical and they do not have any reservations, whatsoever, with allowing and condoning a fraudulent election..
- 6. Pursuant to F.S. 120.168 the defendants had 10 days to respond to the complaint.
- 7. Robert' Rocky' Rochford, Mr. John Peters and Ehsan Joarder chose not to file any objection and the last two were in contempt of your honor's order by failing to appear before you on September 9, 2024

- 8. Wherefore, there is 'No Objection' to Dr. Neelam Taneja Perry's complaint and admission to and acceptance to the ban from the race, by Robert 'Rocky' Rochford, John Peters, Ehsan Joarder pursuant to the complaint.
- 9. Ms. Julie Marcus, who is the Supervisor of Elections and Ms. Amanda
 Coffey, who is the Pinellas County attorney are the gatekeepers of the
 election laws. They intentionally and deliberately did not file any objection
 to the complaint pursuant to the Florida statute.
- 10. As per a witness "Exhibit C"
- 11. Attached is a PDF document of every single Pinellas county voter who Ms. Marcus and her coconspirators illegally requested vote by mail ballots on Sunday June 23, 2024.
- 12. Every single one of these vote by mail ballot requests were made illegally.
- 13. The attachment represents over 89.90% of all the vote by mail ballots sent out.
- 14. This is a massive fraud, and massive NON-COMPLIANCE with Florida Statute 101.62.
- 15. Florida law and Florida Courts have long ruled that Vote by mail is a privilege and not a right, therefore the law related to vote by mail ballots SHALL BE STRICTLY COMPLIED WITH...
- 16. No strict compliance and even a slight presence of fraud renders every single vote by mail ballot ordered on that day illegally requested be deemed invalid.
- 17. There were massive numbers of undeliverable Vote by mail ballots that were sent out and then returned as being cast.
- 19. All Voters list maintenance and the handling of this activity is managed in VR Systems.

- 21. This means that because >89% of the VBM Ballots were requested illegally, there is no other explanation other than for fraud...
- 22. All the VBM ballots illegally requested and ALL of those that should have come back as undeliverable BUT were instead cast and counted are 100% ILLEGAL and SHOULD BE VOIDED according to long standing Florida Supreme Court Rulings.
- 23. VR Systems has a log of the illegally requested VBM Ballots".

24. Fla. Stat. § 102.168 ("(5) A statement of the grounds of contest may not be rejected, nor the proceedings dismissed, by the court for any want of form if the grounds of contest provided in the statement are sufficient to clearly

inform the defendant of the particular proceeding or cause for which the nomination or election is contested.") The response that these defendants filed was late The had 10 days to file, so this is not consistent with the law It was filed on the 12th day. This delay in filing a response is not permitted, see 25. Wherefore, an emergency injunction against certification of the results of the Republican Primary Election held on August 20, 2024 be annulled and declaring Mr. Robert 'Rocky' Rochford, who won by cheating, disqualified and banned from running in the race, James Peters and Ehsan Joarder as abandoning the race and accepting the ban failing to show up for the court- ordered hearing.

The Plaintiff, Neelam Taneja Perry, is the only viable candidate left.

Hence, Dr. Neelam Taneja Perry be declared the nominee of the

Republican Party to be the candidate for US House of Representatives,

Florida, District 14.
