**PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION AND PRODUCTION
REGARDING JANUARY 29, 2026 JAWS UPLOAD EVENTS**

Plaintiff, JOHN WILLIAM LICCIONE, pro se, respectfully moves the Court for clarification and production regarding certain January 29, 2026 Judicial Automated Workflow System ("JAWS") upload notifications and related documents and states:

I. BACKGROUND

1. On January 29, 2026, at 2:40 PM, Plaintiff received two automated JAWS notifications reflecting two separate JAWS document upload events in this case.

2. One notification bore the subject line:

"Judicial Automated Workflow System Cover Letter uploaded for 24-003939-CI."

3. The details within that notification reflected:

- File Description: **ORDER**
- File Type: **PDF**

No document was attached to the email.

4. A contemporaneous second notification bore the subject line:

"Judicial Automated Workflow System file uploaded for 24-003939-CI."

The details within that notification likewise reflected:

- File Description: **ORDER**
- File Type: **PDF**

No document was attached to the email.

5. The 2:40 PM notifications did not reference a “signed” order, nor indicate that a conformed signed order had been uploaded to JAWS; rather, they referenced file uploads described as “...Cover Letter” and “...File”

6. Both upload events were identified as having been uploaded by:

User Name: Lidia Torres

7. At 2:57 PM on January 29, 2026, after receiving the two above-referenced JAWS notifications, Plaintiff emailed the Judicial Assistant requesting a copy of the order referenced in the notifications.

8. Three minutes later at 3:00 PM, Plaintiff received an automated JAWS notification email attaching a conformed, signed Order Granting Defendants’ Motion to Dismiss. The email bore the subject line:

“The following order with the Judicial Automated Workflow System for 24-003939-CI was signed.”

9. Plaintiff has never been provided the PDF documents referenced in the separate 2:40 PM JAWS notifications.

10. No document identified as a “Cover Letter” appears on the Clerk’s public docket for January 29, 2026.

II. BASIS FOR CLARIFICATION

11. The January 29, 2026 JAWS notifications reflect two distinct upload events at 2:40 PM.

12. Plaintiff requested a copy of the “Order” referenced in the notifications, at 2:57 PM.

13. A “signed” order was uploaded and transmitted at 3:00 PM.

14. The document referenced in the separate notification labeled "...Cover Letter uploaded..." has not been provided to Plaintiff.
15. Plaintiff seeks clarification solely to ensure completeness of the record and transparency regarding the referenced JAWS upload events.

III. RELIEF REQUESTED

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court:

- A.** Produce copies of the documents referenced in the two January 29, 2026 JAWS notifications labeled "*Judicial Automated Workflow System Cover Letter uploaded for 24-003939-CI.*" and "*Judicial Automated Workflow System file uploaded for 24-003939-CI.*"
- B.** Identify, with specificity, each document uploaded to JAWS on or about 2:40 PM on January 29, 2026, including:
- 1) the exact filename of each document within the JAWS system;
 - 2) the title or caption of each document;
 - 3) whether each document was generated internally by the Court or provided by Defendants or their counsel; and
 - 4) whether any such document constitutes a draft or unsigned version of the Order later transmitted in signed form at 3:00 PM;
 - 5) the JAWS document category / event type assigned to each upload (including the selection/assignment that generated the subject-line labels "Cover Letter uploaded" and "file uploaded").
- C.** If any document identified in paragraph B was provided by Defendants or their counsel, direct Defendants to confirm:

- 1) the identity of the individual who provided the document;
- 2) the date on which it was provided to the Court; and
- 3) the method of transmittal.

D. Grant such further relief as the Court deems appropriate to clarify the record.
