PROPOSED ORDER FOR TEMPORARY EMERGENCY INJUNCTIVE RELIEF

This cause came before the Court on Plaintiff's Request for Temporary Emergency Injunctive Relief concerning the August 20th, 2024 Congressional District 13 Democratic primary election results. After reviewing the request, exhibits, and the affidavits submitted, and considering the severity of the allegations presented, it is hereby:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

- Defendant Julie Marcus, in her capacity as the Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections, is compelled to produce all election records, specifically the log files or other information systems reports, that document the source IP addresses for the 219,000+ voters who allegedly submitted absentee ballot requests over the Internet on June 23, 2024.
- 2. **Defendant is hereby ordered** to commence an investigation into potential absentee ballot fraud and to conduct a cyber-investigation of the computer systems used in the processing and publishing of election results, including but not limited to government IT systems and systems provided by VR Systems in Tallahassee.
- 3. The certification of the results of the Congressional District 13 Democratic primary election held on August 20, 2024, **is temporarily decertified** pending further order of this Court.
- 4. A **special magistrate is appointed** to oversee the investigations into absentee ballot and election hacking fraud as described herein.
- 5. The **Florida Secretary of State is directed** to conduct an independent cyber-security forensic investigation utilizing a nationally recognized cyber-security firm that has no prior associations with the State of Florida, Pinellas County, any political party or their operatives.

This order is entered without prejudice to the rights of the defendant to contest the allegations made in the plaintiff's request, and a hearing on this matter is scheduled promptly to address the continuation or modification of this temporary order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this temporary emergency injunctive relief is granted based on the necessity to preserve the integrity of the electoral process and the public's trust in democratic institutions.
