THIS CAUSE is before the Court *sua sponte*. Having considered the case file, the applicable law, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, the Court hereby **FINDS** as follows:

1. On October 14, 2025, this Court entered an order dismissing Plaintiff's Second Amended Complaint without prejudice ("Prior Order").

2. The Prior Order afforded Plaintiff twenty days to amend his complaint. Accordingly, the deadline for Plaintiff to file a timely third amended complaint was November 3, 2025.

3. The Prior Order warned Plaintiff that failure to file a timely third amended complaint would result in dismissal of this action with prejudice without further notice.

4. Plaintiff has failed to file a third amended complaint, and the deadline for doing so has passed.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

1. The instant action is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.

2. The Court reserves jurisdiction to consider an award of attorney's fees and costs.
