NOTICE OF INTENT TO USE EVIDENCE  
OF OTHER CRIMES, WRONGS OR ACTS COMMITTED BY THE DEFENDANT

Comes now, BRUCE BARTLETT, State Attorney for the Sixth  
Judicial Circuit of Florida, and hereby files his Notice of  
Intent to Use Evidence of Other Crimes, Wrongs or Acts  
Committed by the Defendant, to-wit:

1. JEFFRY KNIGHT, in the County of Pinellas, State of  
Florida, on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of September, in the year of our  
Lord, two thousand nineteen, did then and there operate a  
vessel upon the waters of the State of Florida and did  
violate the inland navigational rules, to-wit: failed to  
maintain a proper lookout pursuant to United States  
Inland Navigational Rules Act of 1980; Rule 5 Section  
83.05, and as a result of said violation a boating  
accident occurred and caused injury.

2. JEFFRY KNIGHT, in the County of Pinellas, State of Florida, on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of September, in the year of our Lord, two thousand nineteen, did then and there operate a vessel upon the water of the State of Florida in a manner not reasonable or prudent or having regard for other waterborne traffic and all other attendant circumstances so as to endanger the life or limb or property of another.
3. In the foregoing case the State intends to offer the facts of the other case as proof of a material fact at issue including proof of motive, opportunity, intent, preparation, plan, knowledge, identity, absence of mistake or accident, common scheme or plan, or pattern of criminality.
